Professor Andrew Eder was educated at St. Paul's School in London and qualified from King's College Hospital School of Medicine and Dentistry in 1986. In 1989, Professor Eder moved to the Eastman for his postgraduate training and completed a Masters in Conservative Dentistry.

Currently, Professor Eder is Director of Education and Head of the Continuing Professional Development Department at the UCL Eastman Dental Institute. He is also Associate Dean for Continuing Education at the UCL School of Life and Medical Sciences and an Honorary Consultant in Restorative Dentistry. As a Specialist in Restorative Dentistry and Prosthodontics, he also maintains a referral specialist private practice in Central London.

As co-editor of the book, *Tooth Surface Loss* (BDJ publications), and Clinical Director of the London Tooth Wear Centre, Professor Eder has a special interest in clinical aspects of the causes and patterns of tooth surface loss as well as the aesthetic and functional management of patients with tooth wear.

Academic interests also include educational research into online methods of teaching delivery and innovative technology as well as educational feedback and impact on clinical practice. He is also on the editorial boards of the *British Dental Journal*, *Private Dentistry* and the *European Journal of Prosthodontics and Restorative Dentistry*.

Professor Eder is a former President of Alpha Omega, the Royal Society of Medicine's Odontological Section and the British Society for Restorative Dentistry. He is also Chairman of the Charitable Trust of the Alpha Omega London Chapter, an examiner for the Royal College of Surgeons and Postgraduate Tutor for the London Deanery.
